# Anchorage

## **District 9**

Target on W 100th - Carrs on Huffman will not give permission. But the Target on W 100th Ave does pull a substantial amount of signatures from 9 and they allowed us to canvass at the door. This was key to qualifying District 9 for min wage.

## **District 10 / 15**

Carrs on W. Dimond at door. Walmart at Dimond Center allows parking lot only.

## **District 11 / 12 / 13**

Carrs on Abbott at door. They will also let you stand in the vestibule during harsh weather conditions.

## **District 14**

New Sagaya Midtown Market at the door. Great for early morning/lunch rush. Lots of support here.

Midtown Mall - Two people can canvass the Carrs and two people can canvass the REI and produce big numbers.

## **District 16**

Carrs on W. Northern Lights at the door, will let you stand in vestibule during harsh winter conditions.

## **District 17**

5th Ave Mall - Canvass on the 5th Ave/C St walkway on the parking garage side. Great on weekends.

## **District 18 / 23 / 24**

Tikahtnu Commons - Target used to let us stand at door. Due to the nature of the min wage petitions, they pushed us out to parking lot but we can probably get the door back if we finesse it. Burlington/Ultta/Kohls also heavily trafficked and it all gets lots of District 23 & 24 sigs.

Eagle River Carrs at the door and will let you stand in vestibule during harsh winter conditions.

## Districts 19 / 20 / 21 / 22

Carrs on Debarr at the door, will let you stand in vestibule during harsh winter conditions.

Walmart on Debarr parking lot only. Maybe door. Depends on security guard, most are supportive.

Carrs on E. Northern Lights, will let you stand in vestibule during harsh winter conditions. Not as busy as most locations
