Letters to the editor are an important part of building and reinforcing community consensus. If you're working on a letter related to Campaign Contribution Limits, here are some topic areas you might choose to focus on...

- Alaska's previous limits on campaign contributions were established by 73% of voters in 2006.
- Campaign contribution limits make individual Alaskan voices stronger.
- A Federal judge nixed Alaska's previous limits as it had not kept up with inflation, the new initiative has inflation baked in.
- The Governor failed to defend campaign contribution limits and the Legislature has failed to enact updated limits. This leaves the effort to the citizens.
- Contribution limits prevent mega-donors from buying state and local elections.
- Repeals unlimited campaign contributions.
- Signing the initiative petition doesn't mean you support the effort, it just means you support putting it on the ballot and allowing Alaskans to decide.
